

Rules for the Chalk Art

1. The chalk art event will occur consistent with the Governor's Safe Start Washington plan for Jefferson County's current phase and local and State health orders. Participants must wear face coverings and remain at least six feet apart. Groups are limited to five people from the same household.
2. Participants may pick any of the designated spots on Lawrence Street for chalk art that are not immediately adjacent to other participants.
3. Drawings must remain within the lines of the marked spots.
4. The City of Port Townsend reserves the right to remove any drawing that is inconsistent with the nature of the event and community standards.
5. Art should focus on your visions for one or more of the 10 Engage PT initiatives or your hopes and dreams for the future of Port Townsend.
6. All art must be created in chalk. Individual chalk pieces will be provided, so chalk need not be shared. You may bring your own chalk.
7. Art found to violate copyright or trademarks will be removed.
8. If you choose to create art outside the October 10 event (for example, your driveway), you may submit a photo to the City at: engagePT@cityofpt.us through October 31. Chalk kits can be picked up at the Library during curbside hours starting on October 1 while supplies last.
9. By creating art on Lawrence Street during the chalk art event or submitting a photo, you give the City of Port Townsend and the Jefferson County Farmers Market a limited, non-exclusive license to use your art or reproductions of it for non-commercial purposes and materials, including the City or Farmers Market websites, Facebook pages, newsletters, or other materials.
10. Lawrence Street will be closed 8:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday, October 10.
